INTRODUCTION

The Overseas Practicum Class provides an opportunity for students to receive academic credit for an overseas experience. Travel is a vital part of education. This class brings academics and experience together for recognition of achievement. Credits from this course will satisfy the study abroad requirement for students of Linton Global College. This course is primarily for students who have participated in a Linton Global College sponsored educational travel experience. However, other travel experiences may be considered for credit if 1) the student has not received other academic or volunteer credit, 2) the trip was at least two weeks in length, 3) the trip included significant educational and/or cultural content (no package tours or family travel). Please contact the course instructor to see if your travel experience can qualify for academic credit.

CLASS PROCEDURES

Students who meet the above requirements can enroll in this class. The class will meet only once or twice to explain the remaining requirements which will depend on the type of travel experience. Additional reading, reports and presentation may be required to receive full credit. The trip leader may be asked to fill out a "participant evaluation" form.
